CONSOLIDATED CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ORGANIZATIONAL CHART

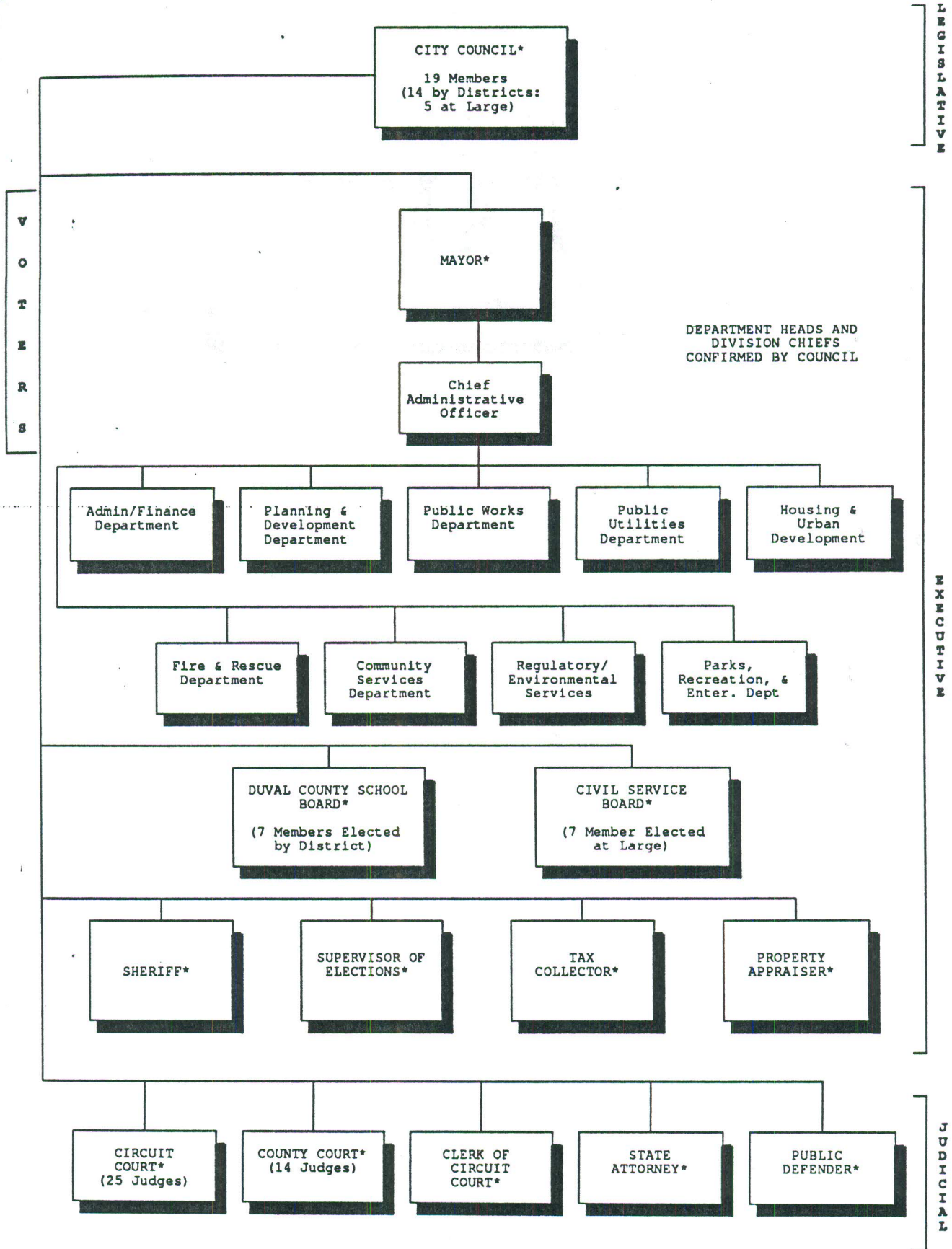

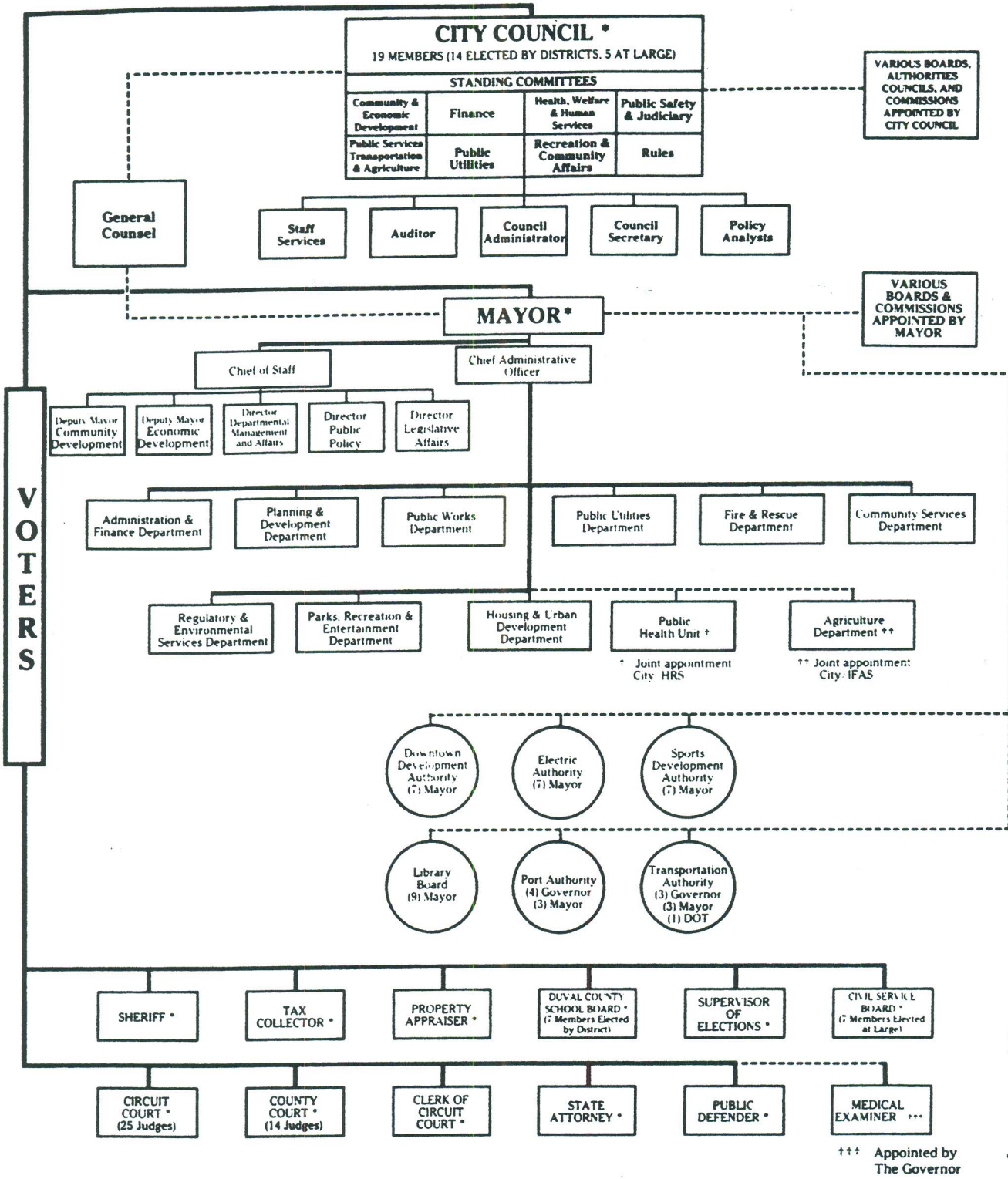
CONSOLIDATED CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ORGANIZATIONAL CHART

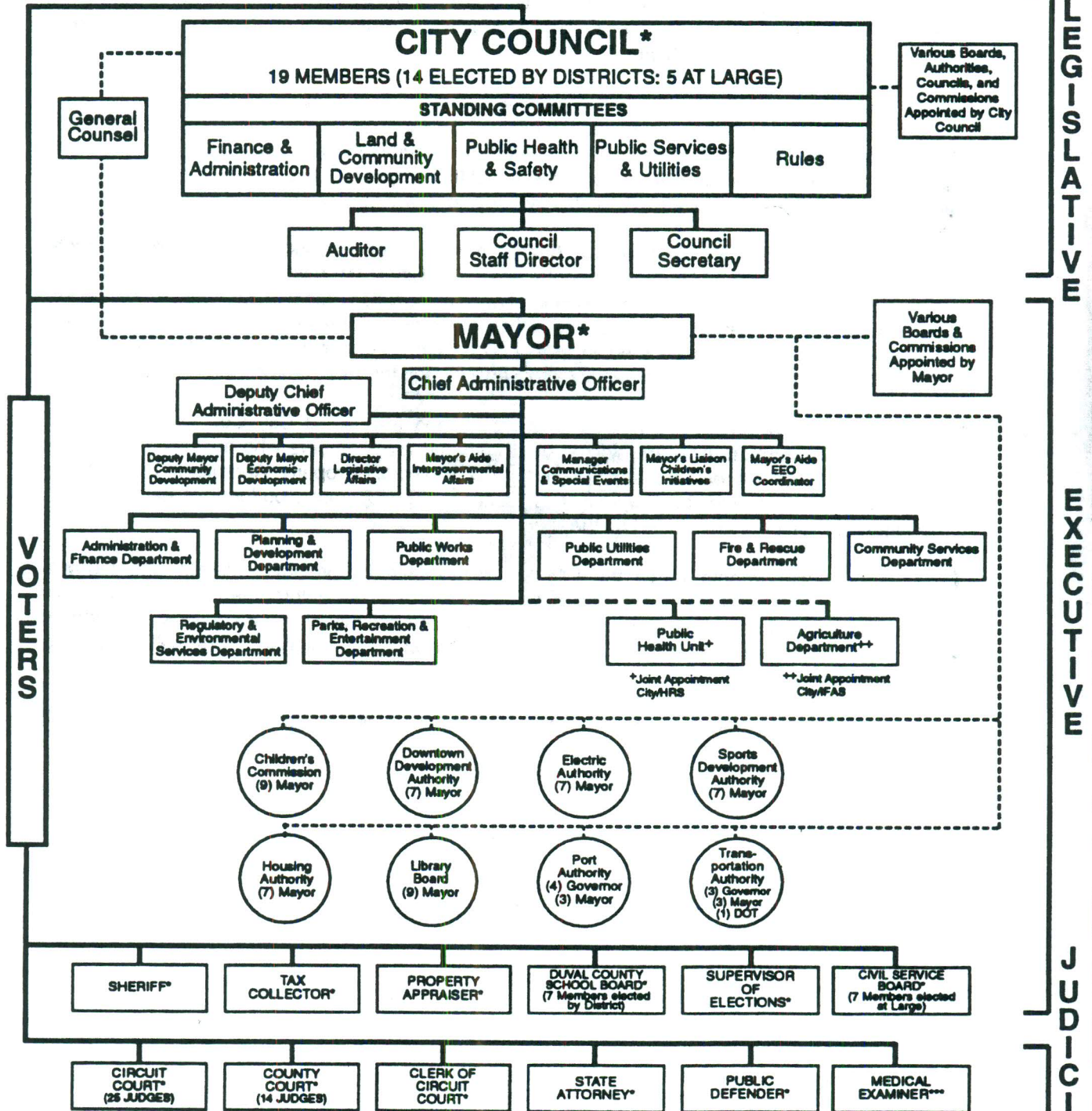

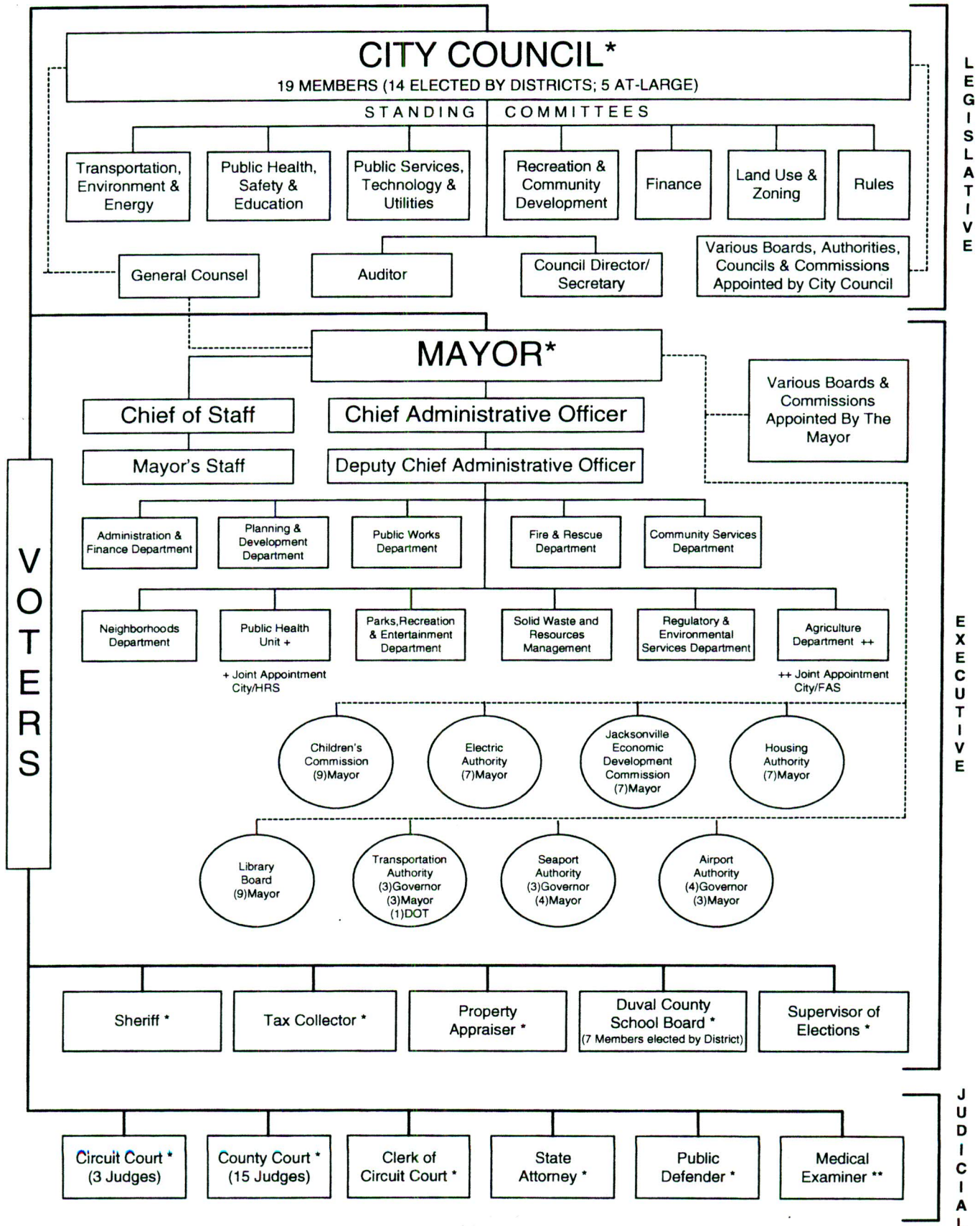

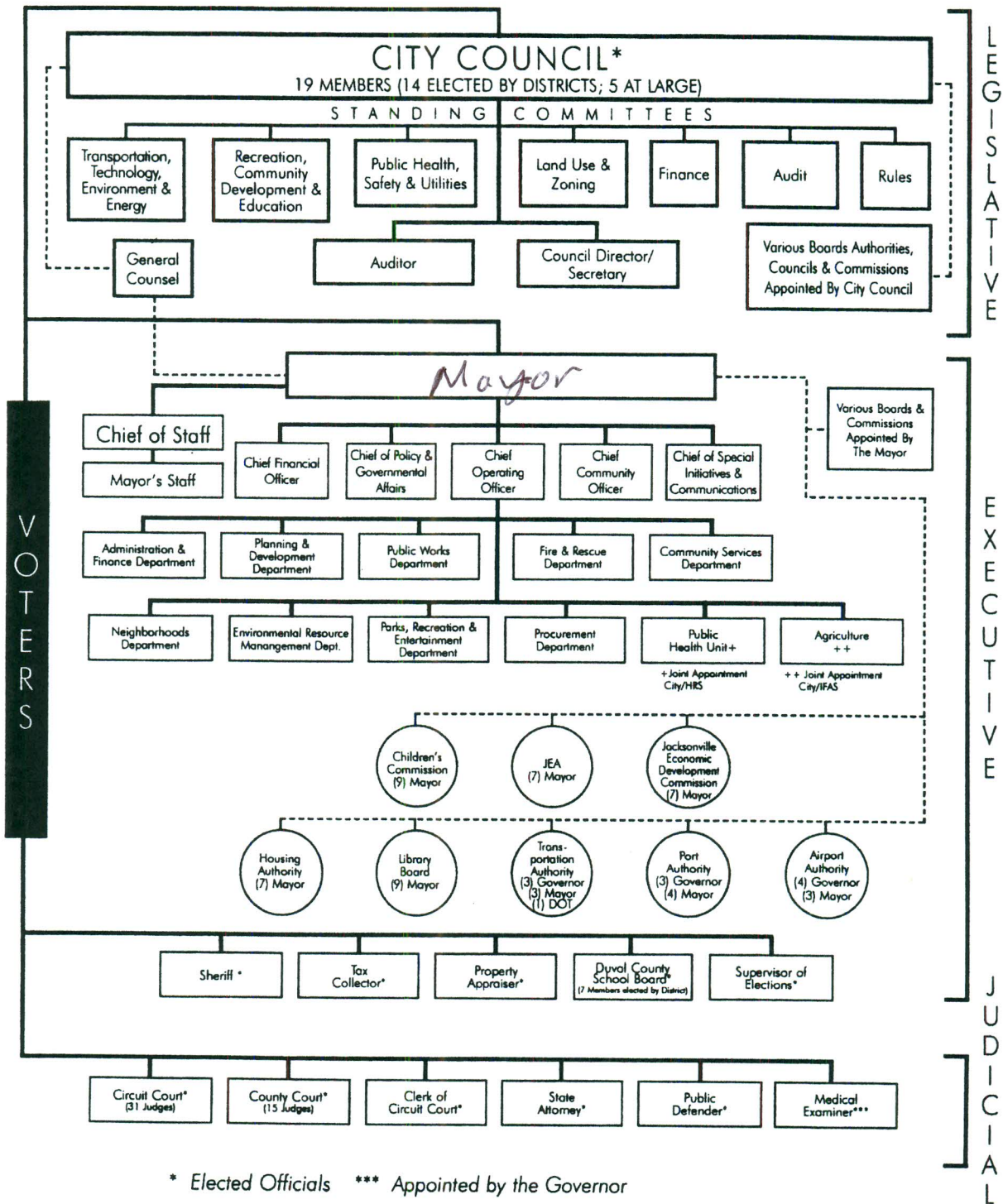

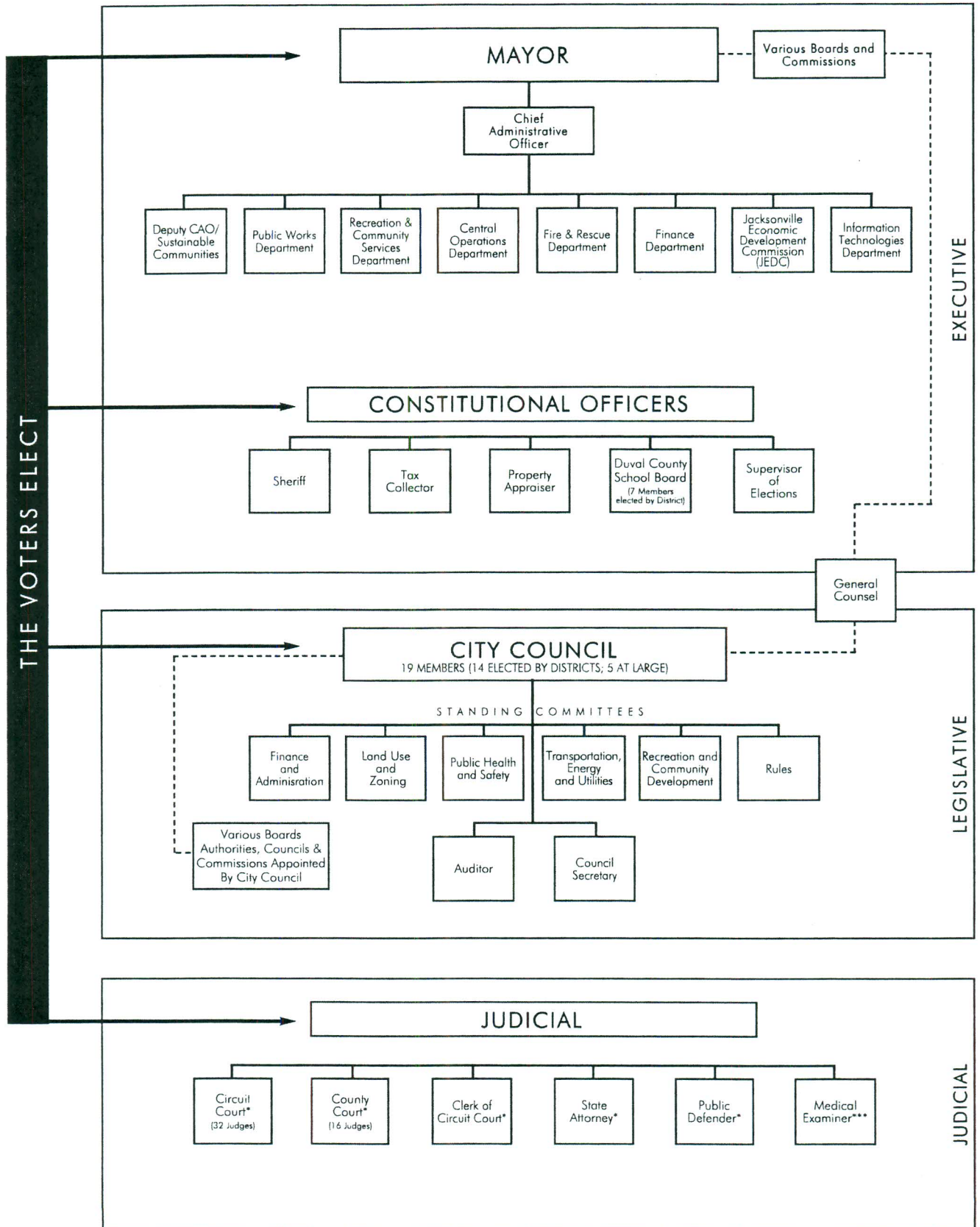
