

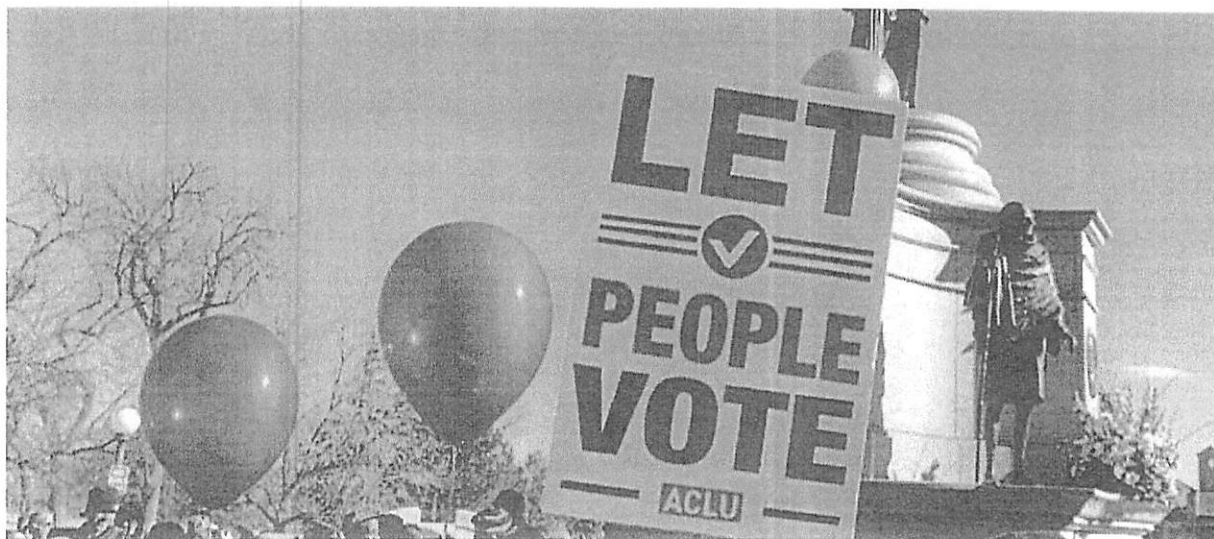

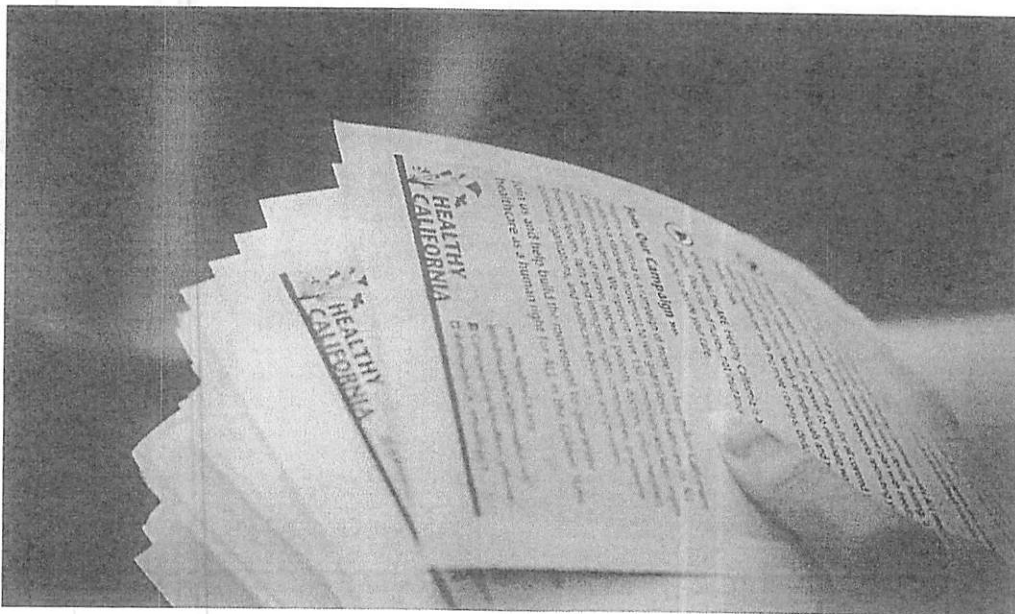

What should I do?



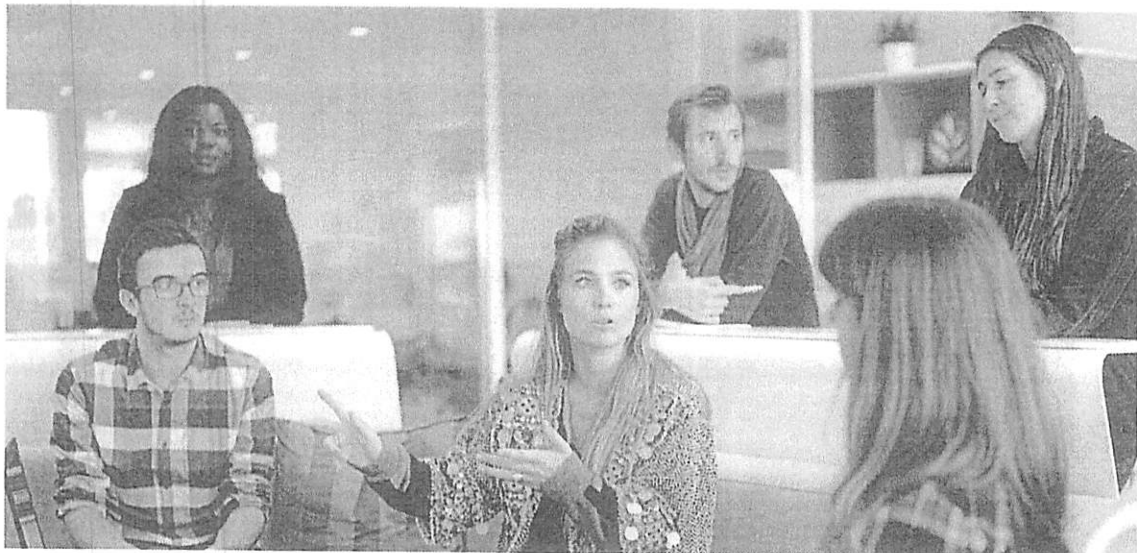
