**NOTICE TO PUBLIC OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD  
for the 2024 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

Notice is given that the City of Jacksonville's ("City") Housing and Community Development Division ("HCDD") has made available a draft of the 2024 Annual Action Plan ("AAP") for a period of 30 days. The AAP provides a summary of the actions, activities, and specific resources that will be used each year to address needs and goals identified by the 2021 – 2025 Consolidated Plan.

The City's FY 2024 federal funding allocations amounts are:

Emergency Solutions Grant: \$582,374      Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS: \$3,112,672  
HOME Investment Partnership: \$3,247,217      Community Development Block Grant: \$6,853,388

Citizens are encouraged to participate in the development of the AAP and review and make comments on the draft plan. The comment period for the draft 2024 AAP is **July 1, 2024 to July 30, 2024**.
