To qualify for the stormwater and solid waste fees Low-Income Exemption, all household's occupants' Gross Annual Household Income must be within 150% of the current year's federal poverty guidelines according to the number of individuals in the household. The annual federal poverty guidelines are set by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and are typically published every January in the *Federal Register* and on the HHS website, <u>aspe.hhs.gov/poverty-guidelines</u>.

2025 EXEMPTION PROGRAM INCOME THRESHOLDS

Per City Ordinance Code Section 382.504(a)(1), this program applies to the residential solid waste [garbage] fee. Additionally, exemptions provided for ad valorem taxes, such as those granted for senior citizens, disability or widow/widower, **ARE NOT** applicable to stormwater or solid waste fees. If you have questions about paying your property tax bill, please contact the Tax Collector's Office at (904) 255-5700.

Per Ordinance 2025-2-E, the solid waste fee exemption does not eliminate the solid waste fee. The solid waste fee exemption keeps the solid waste fee amount at \$12.65 per month (\$151.80 per calendar year).

EARLY FILING DEADLINE – JULY 31, 2025: Complete applications that are submitted by this date *may* be approved or denied before tax bills are issued, but it is not guaranteed. You are responsible for making sure your tax bill remains in good standing until a decision is rendered.

FINAL DEADLINE – MARCH 31, 2026: All applications and supporting documentation *must* be received by this date. If your application is approved after the tax bills are issued, you will either receive a refund or a new bill. New bills will provide a 30-day extension on any early payment discounts for which you may qualify.

Regardless of the decision made on your application, you are solely responsible for ensuring your property tax bill remains in good standing. Failure to pay your bill by its final due date may result in penalties as prescribed by law.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- The applicant must be listed as an owner of the property for which an exemption is sought, or otherwise be an appointed representative who is legally authorized to act on behalf of the owner. The applicant must sign the application if sending by post mail.
- The exemption program is available for stormwater and solid waste fees charged to the property containing the applicant's primary residence. Exemptions are not permitted for stormwater and solid waste fees charged to rental properties or non-residential properties
- Ownership may be verified using information available from the Duval County Property Appraiser and the Duval County Clerk of Courts. All occupants of the household must be listed in Section 3 of the application. All sources of income for all occupants of the household must be provided.
- Applicants listing zero income must provide supporting documentation explaining how household expenses are being met. The Social Services Division may contact applicants to request additional information. Failure to respond will result in denial.
- Information and documents that are provided to support eligibility will be handled in accordance with state law governing public records.
- In addition to the details provided by the applicant, the Social Services Division may, at its discretion, review other sources of public information related to the
 property and/or the applicant, including property tax, JEA and/or other utility records, to determine eligibility.
