

Discover JaxParks

All programs are guided trail walks unless otherwise noted. RSVP is encouraged for all programs but is required for bike and kayak tours.

- Trail Walk / Nature Walk: Join a Jacksonville Park Naturalist for a leisurely hike to explore trails at our parks and preserves. Park naturalist will point out birds, wildflowers, and other wildlife seen along the way. Arrive at the meeting location ready to hit the trails by the advertised start time. Outside programs may be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances such as inclement weather, etc. RSVP is recommended at JaxParks Reservation Site at JaxParks.coj.net
- **Bike Tour:** Participation limited to a maximum of 12 people. <u>Bring your own bike</u> JaxParks does not have bikes or helmets available to rent. The concessionaire at Hanna Park is a recommended vendor; inquire about bike rentals at 904-252-7024. Outside programs may be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances such as inclement weather, etc. **RSVP is required at JaxParks Reservation Site at JaxParks.coj.net**
- **Kayak Tour:** Participation limited to a maximum of 18 people. <u>Bring your own kayak</u> JaxParks does not have kayaks available for rental. Arrive half an hour before the program start time. The concessionaire at Hanna Park is a recommended vendor; inquire about kayak rentals at 904-252-7024. Outside programs may be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances such as inclement weather, etc.

Nature Centers

Nature center hours may vary due to staff availability or special events. If visiting these parks just for the nature centers, you are encouraged to call ahead.

- <u>Tillie K Fowler Regional Park</u> Nature Center Hours: 1-4 PM, Fridays-Sundays (904) 255-6879. 7000 Roosevelt Blvd. Turn off Roosevelt Blvd onto Norman Street (across from NAS Jax entrance) and follow the road until it ends at a loop. Nature center is across from the bathrooms. Additional amenities: Park has an outdoor classroom for use with nature center, a dog park, hiking and biking trails, and a pavilion available for rental. Rentals can be made online at JaxParks.com
- Huguenot Memorial Park

 Tues-Sun Memorial Day-Labor Day, Fri-Sun off-season

 (904) 255-4255. 10980 Heckscher Drive. Turn off Heckscher onto park entrance at the blinking light. Nature center is located near the bathrooms. An entrance fee required to enter the park.

 Nature Center open Tues-Sun from Memorial Day- Labor Day, and Fridays through Sundays during off-season. Additional amenities: Park is primarily a drive-on beach. There is a playground near the nature center. Park offers camping and shelter rentals. Call park or go to JaxParks.com for reservations.
- Kathryn Abbey Hanna Park

 (904) 255- 6767. 500 Wonderwood Drive. Wonderwood drive leads to the park entrance. Nature center is located in the campground; please visit the park office to gain access to the campground during nature center hours. An entrance fee is required to enter the park.

 Additional amenities: Park has 1.5 miles of beach, a 60-acre lake, over 20 miles of hiking and biking trails, kayak and bike rentals, over 200 campsites, shelters available for rental, a children's splash park, and an event venue. Call park or go to JaxParks.com for reservations.

Please note: Pets are not permitted inside public buildings. Please do not bring food into nature centers. Children must be accompanied by a guardian at all times inside nature centers.
