James Holderfield also held a moment of silence in honor of the first responders who lost their lives on September 11, 2001.

#### II. Public Speaking

Randy Wyse addressed the ongoing Florida Blue—Baptist Health dispute concerning health insurance coverage. He reported that the Jacksonville Police Officers' and Firefighters' Health Insurance Trust (JPOFFHIT) had met with leadership from both Florida Blue and Baptist Health to voice their concerns. Wyse emphasized JPOFFHIT's strong desire for the two parties to reach an agreement, as the issue is significantly affecting JPOFFHIT members. He shared that insurance claims have skyrocketed, and communication between JPOFFHIT, Florida Blue, and Baptist Health has been active and ongoing. Wyse thanked the Advisory Committee for their support and urged them to stay informed as negotiations progress, expressing hope for a resolution.

James Holderfield then thanked Randy Wyse for his efforts in keeping healthcare costs manageable for JPOFFHIT members.

#### IV. Executive Director's Report

a. 2024 Advisory Committee Election Update

Steve Lundy provided an update on the election timeline for the Advisory Committee. Two positions are up for election, currently held by Fire Captain Christopher Stover and Police Officer James Holderfield, whose terms expire on December 31, 2024. The new terms will run from January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2029. Key dates include:

- September 23, 2024 (Monday) Qualification Notice will be sent to active JSO and JFRD members via email.
- October 4, 2024 (Friday, at 4:00 PM) Qualification Deadline.
- October 9, 2024 (Wednesday) Candidate Announcement will be sent to active JSO and JFRD members via email and posted on the website.
- November 1, 2024 (Friday) Election opens (online voting).
- November 15, 2024 (Friday, at 12:01 AM) Voting Deadline (online).

There will be one ballot for active JSO members to elect their JSO Advisory Member and one for active JFRD members to elect their JFRD Advisory Member.
