(3) I am working with the teacher who sponsors the Safety Patrols in order to put on a dance for the students after FCAT on April $26^{\text {th }}$.
Challenges: We had a few low attendance days as we neared Spring Break. Other than the ADA, there are no other challenges at this time. We are looking to add a few more students in April.
