The Student Advisory Board continued to address challenging issues such as anti- bullying and peer pressure and included doing community service. TEAM UP program Director Mr. Peterson and Lead Teacher Mrs. Richards continue to work together with Principal Brown to ensure all of our students are prepared academically this year to ensure promotion for all grade levels.
