Program Strategy: Keeping Kids Safe – Productive

Program Summary: TEAM UP is an after school program that provides academic instruction, tutoring and support, as well as, enrichment activities, such as field trips, dance sports and arts to low income, at risk kids. These programs are housed in elementary and middle schools, and provide services directly after school for approximately 3 hours per day, five days per week.

Successes:

Communities In Schools of Jacksonville has formed a partnership with Naval Air Station Jacksonville whereby pilots came out to share with Mayport TEAM UP students about the importance of staying in school and how doing well in school could lead to career opportunities specifically related to becoming a pilot. Enlisted servicemen and military volunteers talked about how math and science is critical in having a successful career as a pilot. This new partnership was presented over three days during Black History Month. Youth were shown the movie Red Tails and were allowed to discuss with pilots the struggles and victories of the famed Tuskegee Airmen. On the second day, pilots talked about their careers as pilots and what they had to do to become pilots. On the last day of the presentation a serviceman shared the historical significance of the Tuskegee Airman. He brought with him artifacts that were important to these men of honor which chronicled their historic significance to World War II. This partnership was established through the DREAM project (Duval Reads Engaging America's Military). The program presented by AmeriCorps is dedicated to sharing with military students the significance and impact of the military in our community.

Academics:

- Youth are still actively recovering missed assignments and taking advantage of the opportunity to make up work that they performed poorly on
- Progress reports were assigned in the final week of February and students continue to show improvement
- Students are taking responsibility for making sure assignments are being turned in to ensure proper grading, etc.

Enrichment:

- Students are now forming intramural basketball teams. This year there is a strong interest in young ladies playing basketball, because of that interest we now have formed our first girls team which will participate in the CIS Flaming Nets tournament
- Our step team continues to prepare for competition and regularly performs step as a form of community service in the Mayport community and at school for assemblies
- Black history showcase which allowed students to present in their own way, works from Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.,
 Maya Angelou, Sojourner Truth, to name a few were recited. The students have decided to celebrate women's history during the month of March

Challenges

• Challenges are minimal however we continue to stress the importance of the need for an increase in funding to serve the growing number of students that we continue to serve on a daily basis. Funds are needed to support additional staffing in order to stay in ratio.
