## Program Strategy: Keeping Kids Safe - Productive

Program Summary: TEAM UP is an after school program that provides academic instruction, tutoring and support, as well as, enrichment activities, such as field trips, dance sports and arts to low income, at risk kids. These programs are housed in elementary and middle schools, and provide services directly after school for approximately 3 hours per day, five days per week.

## Successes:

Academics:

- Youth are taking advantage of the ability to actively engage with school teachers during after school
- Youth have been challenged to meet all book reading assignments. Students are currently on book three
- TEAM UP participants have shown great progress academically. With the distribution of report cards youth are focusing on academic success

Enrichment:

- The football team's roster has greatly increased. Young men and women are attending the practices daily to prepare themselves for the intramural games with other CIS TEAM UP sites
- Youth have set a goal for active participation to not have any behavioral infractions during the day and during TEAM UP. Youth also are striving to have no grades less than C


## Challenges:

- With recent reductions in funds the program has limited resources. With the lowering of the average daily attendance the program struggles to provide the basic requirements of the program which includes: security, field trips, supplies and adequate staffing for the number of youth now seeking to participate. The program has had to reduce transportation and security services in order to maintain staffing
