*\*112.324(2)(a), (c), (e), F.S., provide in pertinent part: "The complaint and records relating to the complaint or to any preliminary investigation held by...a Commission on Ethics and Public Trust established by any...municipality...are confidential and exempt from the provisions of s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. Any . . . proceeding conducted by...a Commission on Ethics and Public Trust, ...pursuant to a complaint or preliminary investigation, is exempt from the provisions of s. 286.011, s 24(b), Art. I of the State Constitution, and s. 120.525. The exemptions in paragraphs (a)-(d) apply until: 1. [t]he complaint is dismissed as legally insufficient; [t]he alleged violator requests in writing that such records and proceedings be made public; 3. [t]he commission determines that it will not investigate the referral; or 4. . . . a Commission on Ethics and Public Trust . . . determines, based on such investigation, whether probable cause exists to believe that a violation has occurred."*
